

INFORMATION ABOUT MOAT FARM JUNIOR SCHOOL.

Moat Farm Junior School is a large 4 form entry primary school. We have about 480 children on roll. Children enter school at 7 and leave us at 11. The school has good standards of academic success and is always well above Sandwell's averages in all subjects for Key Stage 2 SATs. Our students are generally polite, well behaved and eager to learn. Our last Ofsted inspection, (2013) gave us a judgement of "Good."

We have a large staff of 20 teachers who are at varying stages of their careers. Our classroom support staff team consists of 16 staff, some of whom are LSPs and some of whom are LSAs. Two staff are HLTA s. We also have 2 Learning Mentors.

Our students are generally polite, well behaved and eager to learn. Similarly parents are mostly very supportive of school and turn out for Parents' Evenings, school plays, etc is always high. The School Council plays an active part in school life.

We have been delivering our foundation subjects through a creative curriculum for the last 4 years and we strive to give our students plenty of varied educational experiences both in school and out of school. The performing arts are developing into a major strength of the school. We set by ability for Literacy and Numeracy. Planning takes place in a supportive year group environment. We have a healthy diet of extended school activities. All PPA takes place on Tuesday or Thursday afternoons and staff are at liberty to leave school at lunchtimes on their allotted day.

The school is well resourced and every class has an interactive whiteboard. Our computer suite is kitted out with Apple mac desktops and there are also 2 full class sets of Macbook laptops. All teaching staff have full access to their own Macbook.

The successful applicant will need to be able to work well in a large school setting, strive to achieve high academic standards with those they teach and demonstrate a capacity for hard work and dedication.
