World Read Aloud Day (5th February 2020)

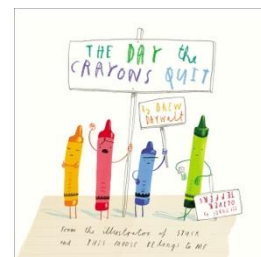
Our Y6 librarians will be delivering a special assembly for pupils in Y3 and 4. Please try to encourage your child to read as much as loud as they can on this day!

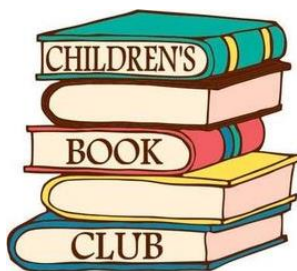

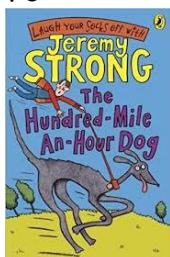


World Book Day (5th March 2020)

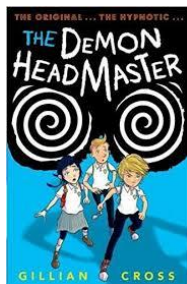
This year we will be exploring the book 'The Day the Crayons quit'. **Children are invited to dress up in their favourite colour or in the colour of the class that they are in.**



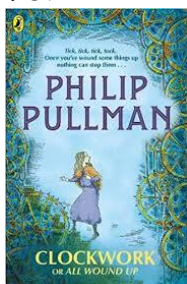

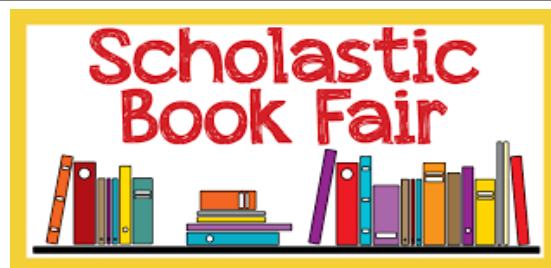

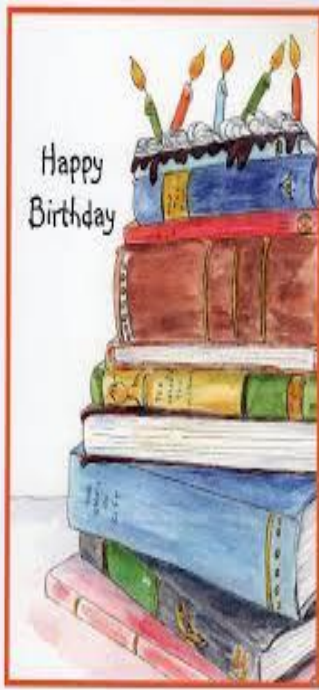


Thank you for all the money that you raised at the book fair last term. It was a grand total of £1,621.28!

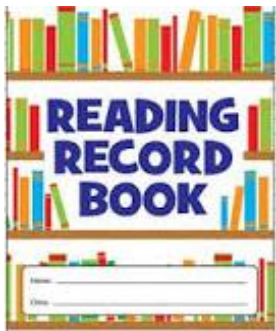
