French Overview 2023/2024

Pupils are introduced to speaking French with a phonics lesson that focusses on the first four phonemes in French. Following this, they complete the 'I am learning French' module, where they listen attentively to key phrases and then develop accurate pronunciation and intonation of these phrases when speaking themselves. Sound, meaning and spellings of words are developed through exploring language patterns in rhymes and songs. These play an integral role in engaging, lively and inclusive lessons. As children become more confident in summer term, they are encouraged to always speak in full sentences using familiar vocabulary, phrases and language structures. The I am able unit allows students to develop more complex sentences using ten new verbs and the aim is to be able to explain things that they can do and things that they cannot do by the end of the unit.
