They also learnt about the differences between the lives of rich and poor during the Tudor period. In the afternoon, the children did a tour of the building and explored the seven priest hides (the most priest hides in one building in England). It was fascinating to hear about the dangers faced by Catholic priests in Elizabethan England and the ingenious ways in which they avoided capture! The children had a wonderful time and came back with so much to talk about and to explore further in our history curriculum.

They took part in various workshops including water safety, rope making and learnt all about the River Severn – the longest river in England!
