

## <u>Moat Farm Junior School Curriculum Overview – Year 3 Summer 2</u>

SUBJECTS	UNIT
Reading	Our theme for this half term is 'Diversity'. To support this theme, we will be reading a wide variety of genre including a fiction book called 'Max and the Millions' by Ross Montgomery, a non-fiction book called 'Six Dots: A story of Young Louis Braille' by Jen Bryant, 'Sophia the Dreamer and her Magical Afro', a poem by Jessica Wilson and a picture book called 'The Invisible' by Tom Percival.
Writing	Our writing will link to our recent Science theme of Forces and Magnets. Our focus text will be 'The Iron Man' by Ted Hughes.  We will be writing a selection of different text types: a non-chronological report, a letter of complain and a piece of instructional writing. We will begin the half term with a piece of writing linked to our school values.
Maths	We will learn about money and time, then recap on the areas already covered this year.
Science	Plants and animals.
RE	Our topic is called 'What do Christians learn from the creation story?'
History	We will be continuing with our topic investigating the Ancient Sumer people.
Geography	We will be continuing with our Mountains and Volcanoes topic. We will be studying volcanoes in more detail.
P.E.	We will be doing athletics, as well as activities decided by individual class teachers.

D & T	Our topic will be food, so we will be creating a series of food dishes.
