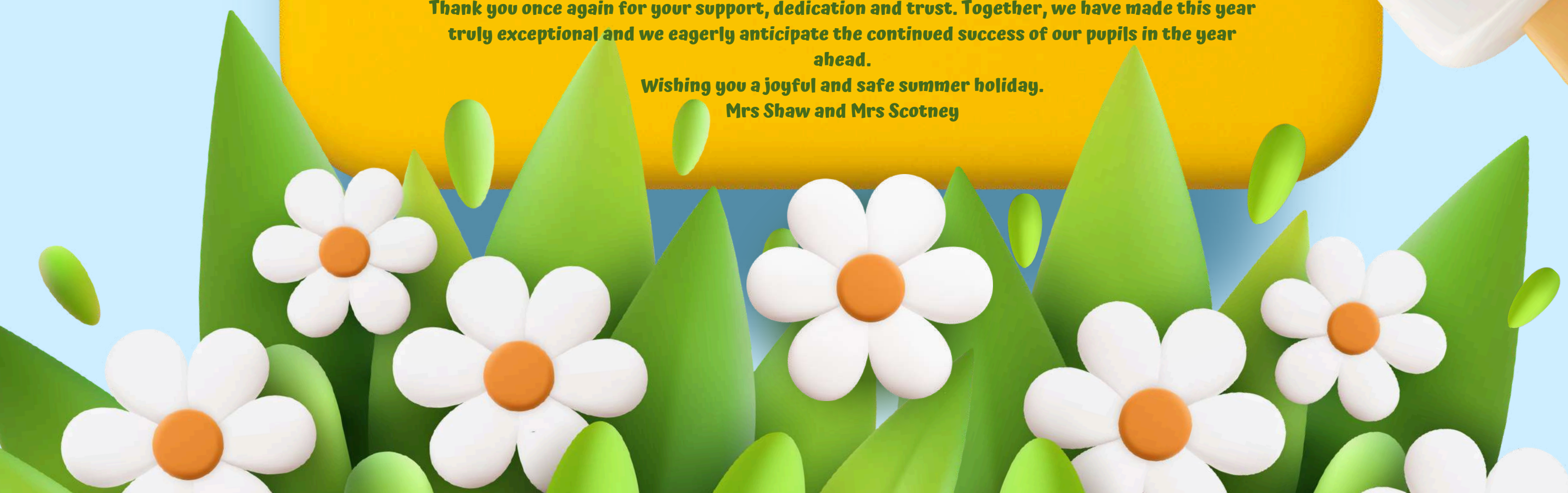


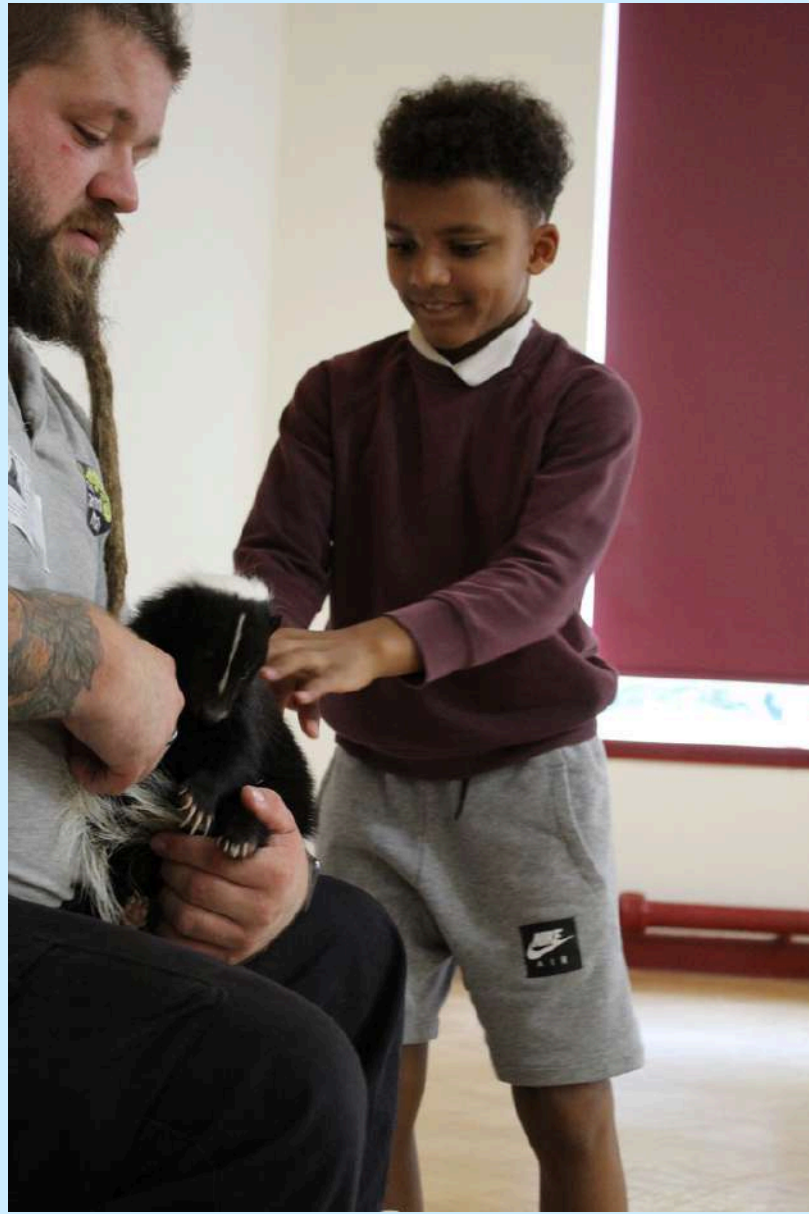


CAMPING
