

Moat Farm Junior School Curriculum Overview – Year 5 Autumn 2

SUBJECTS	UNIT
Reading	The theme is 'Conflict'. We are exploring non-fiction, fiction, poetry and picture books that relate to this theme.
Writing	The writing themes are based around the text 'The Lost Whale' - a non-chronological report about a sea creature, narrative and a diary outcome.
Maths	Addition and subtraction including the inverse operations. Multiplication and division. Area/ Perimeter and Shape.
Science	Forces – this includes gravity, water resistance, air resistance and friction.
RE	What type of king was Jesus (Christianity)?
History	The Tudors - Henry VIII, Reformation, Elizabeth I, Spanish Armada, Great Explorers.
Geography	North America continued – Biomes, tourism, climate change.
P.E.	Football and Tennis- Introduce and refine skills, body positioning and footwork. Green 5 finish swimming lessons and Blue 5 start (see previous correspondence with dates).
Computing	Creating Media – Video Production.
D&T	Bridge structures. Textiles - reviewing stitches to create a winter themed gift.
French	My family – continued.
Art	Typography
Music	Sing and play in different styles – listening and responding to different styles of music including pop, 20 th & 21 st century orchestral and gospel music. Singing as part of a choir.
